## Tips for Parents of Fifth Grade Readers

- Talk to your child about what they're reading. Ask them to summarize the story for you, ask them what they think about the book and why. Reading comprehension and analysis are important skills your child will need throughout their education.
- Introduce your child to lots of different types of reading material. Have magazines, newspapers, and books around at home available to read and look at together. Explore new genres as well, like poetry, graphic novels, audiobooks, and informational titles.
- Encourage your child to read simply for pleasure. Let your child have ownership over the books they choose to read. If they are able to choose a title about a topic they love, they'll be much more likely to enjoy reading.
