Join us for some serious—and not so serious— discussions of contemporary nonfiction books!

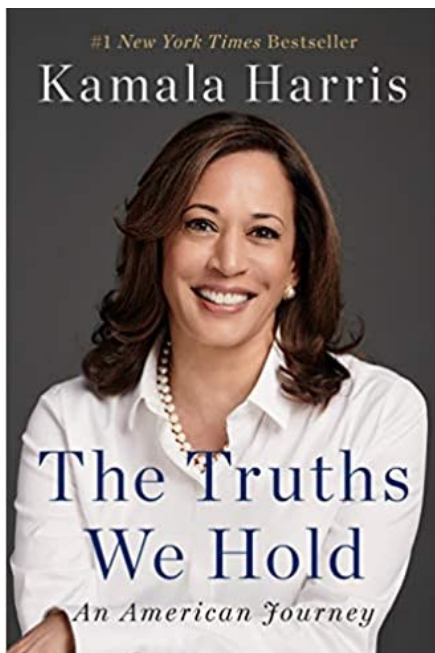

By Kamala Harris

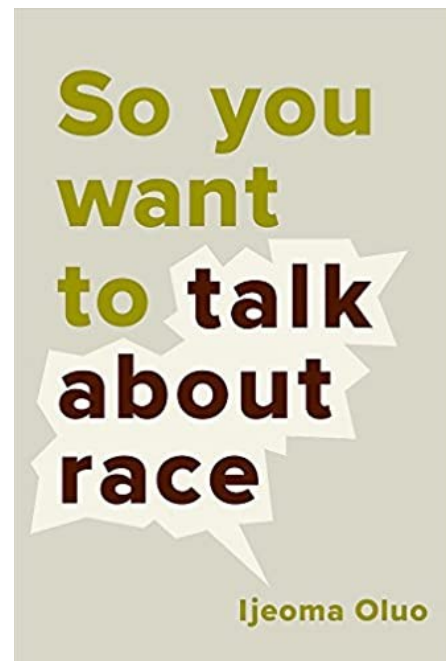
